

Duke Energy 2025 Site Readiness Program

Duke Energy is committed to developing properties to attract growth opportunities to our communities. Through Duke Energy's Site Readiness Program, we partner with nationally recognized site consultants to provide funding and expertise to help communities assess, improve and increase awareness of industrial sites and buildings in our service territory. The program goal is to help further develop prime sites to increase their marketability.

Eligibility Requirements

To qualify for program consideration, the site or building must:

- Be primarily served by Duke Energy.
- Industrial sites can be a single site for a large facility or a potential industrial park (multi-tenant site); 60 acres or more preferred, but not necessary to apply.
- Industrial buildings should be vacant and at least 20,000 square feet.

Site Assessments

Full Site Readiness: Sites that are ready to be run through a site visit with a consultant.

- A desktop analysis of the each submitted site will be performed by an engineering firm.
- A nationally-recognized site selection consultant, sends a request-for-information (RFI) to gather site and community data. The local economic development officials will have a month to complete the request.
- Following the submission of the RFI, a site visit will take place involving a thorough assessment of the property and an in-depth meeting to review the RFI response and any additional questions.
- The consultant will return to the community to present an educational overview of economic development and their final recommendations for the site to the local economic development officials and their selected guests.
- Participating communities will receive a \$10,000 grant to help them implement recommendations to improve the marketability of the site.

Site Readiness Light: Sites that are not yet ready to be run through a site visit with a consultant.

- An engineering firm will conduct a desktop analysis as well as a detailed report including maps and a site questionnaire (completed by the community) to assist the community in site submissions.
- Participating communities will receive a \$10,000 grant to help them implement recommendations to improve the marketability of the site.

Building Assessments

Full Site Readiness: Sites that are ready to be run though a site visit with a consultant.

• The building evaluation component of our program incorporates a similar process as above, but enlists the services of a nationally-recognized site selection consultant.

Duke Energy may submit corporate news releases featuring selected properties to their local media. Program Timeline: Applications will be due March 24, 2025 and participants will be selected and announced in April 2025.
